New Permanent Automatic Traffic Recorder (ATR) Site

A new ATR was installed on SR 40 in North Franklin Township of Washington County. The site, identified as ATR 396, collects volume in all three lanes.

New Permanent Weigh-In-Motion (WIM) Site

The WIM site located on I-80 in Wolf Creek Township of Mercer County was reinstalled and upgraded. The site was upgraded to a Virtual Weigh-In-Motion (VWIM) site. The virtual aspect utilizes cameras to capture images of every truck passing over the sensors. The images can be remotely accessed by staff. This system has a dual purpose. It is used by PennDOT to collect traffic and weight data and by the State Police as a screening tool for weight enforcement.

New Short-Term Video Camera Systems

PennDOT acquired eight camera systems to assist field staff in collecting short term traffic data. PennDOT is able to temporarily affix the units and collect video in locations difficult for staff to install tubes on the roadway. Staff is then able to access the data and manually classify the vehicles.
