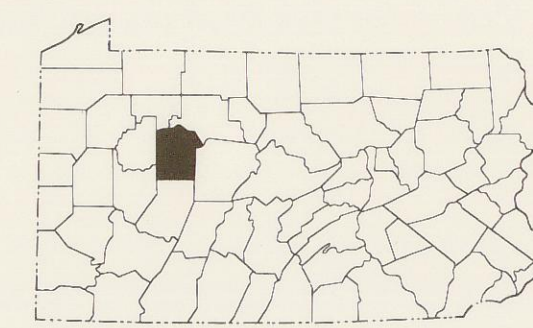
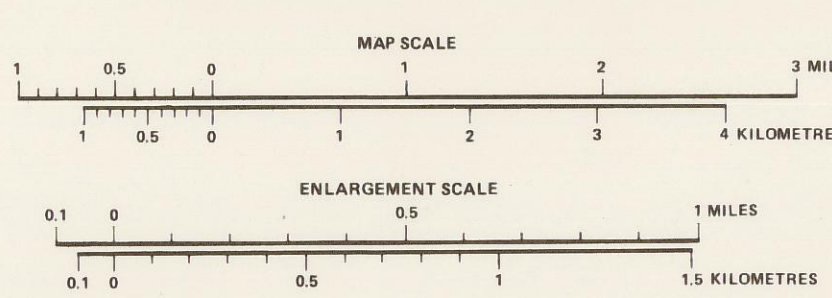


GENERAL HIGHWAY MAP JEFFERSON COUNTY PENNSYLVANIA
