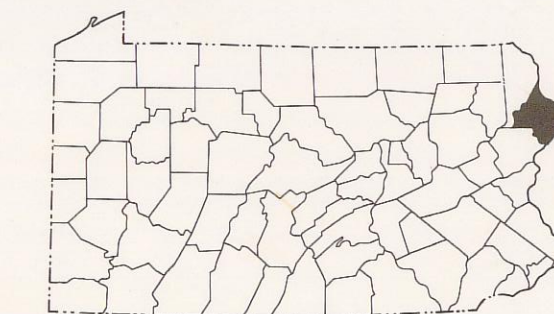
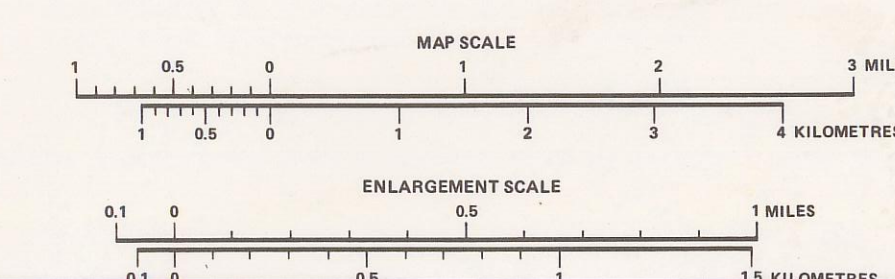
PENNSYLVANIA-NEW JERSEY STATE LINE

"THE TREATY OF 1783 BETWEEN NEW JERSEY AND PENNSYLVANIA DECLARES THE DELAWARE RIVER A COMMON HIGHWAY ON WHICH THE TWO STATES SHALL EXERCISE CONCURRENT JURISDICTION BETWEEN SHORES. THE TREATY OF 1766 SPECIALLY ALLOCATES CERTAIN ISLANDS TO EACH STATE. TITLE TO THE BED AND CHANNEL OF THE DELAWARE RIVER EXTENDS FROM EACH STATE TO THE MIDDLE OF THE RIVER. SEE NOTE TO FINDINGS STATUTES OF PENNSYLVANIA SECTION 804."
